Between January and October 2005 Antonio had 2-3 mild colic episodes spaced months apart. I treated each episode myself with Banamine and Gas-X. Each episode resolved quickly within 20 minutes and the horse returned to normal behavior. I attributed the colics to the horse's eating habits (he eats very fast, especially his hay) and I started to give him his hay in smaller amounts more frequently and to spread it out more over the ground to slow down his eating.

During the first few weeks of October in one ten day period Antonio had three mild colic episodes. All three episodes resolved within 20 minutes with Banamine and Gas-X and the horse returned to normal behavior. On 10/19/05 after the third episode I notified my veterinarian, who suspected ulcers and recommended we start treating him with Gastro-Gard, which we began on 10/19/05. We scheduled Antonio for a gastroscopic exam at the New England Equine Medical and Surgical Center, which was performed on 10/28/05. Gastroscopic exam indicated gastric ulcers.

- 10/19 to 11/4/2005 Administered 1000# dose of Gastro-Gard daily.
- 10/28 Antonio had gastroscopy exam at NEEM&SC. Diagnosis: gastric ulcers.
- 11/4 to 11/18 Administered 625# dose of Gastro-Gard daily (Note: horse gained weight since starting on Gastro-Gard; went from 1000 lbs to 1150 lbs).
- 11/14 Antonio had another mild colic episode that resolved within 20 minutes with Banamine and Gas-X. Notified vet. He said it sounded more like large intestine problem and he did not think it was related to ulcers.
- 11/19 Began administering 250# dose of Gastro-Gard daily.
- 11/26 Antonio had another mild colic episode that resolved within 20 minutes with Banamine and Gas-X.
- 11/27 Began to administer twice daily dose of U-guard. Will continue with this dosage indefinitely.
- 12/8 Antonio appeared to be somewhat uncomfortable. He was a little listless but did not lie down as he usually does with a colic. I kept him under observation and the discomfort eventually resolved itself.
- 12/10 Antonio had another mild colic episode that resolved within 10 minutes with Banamine and Gas-X.
- 12/15 Started Antonio on Digest-It once a day and 12 tablets of simethicone twice a day. Continued with 250# dose of Gastro-Gard once a day and U-Gard twice a day.
- 12/22 Discontinued Gastro-Gard. Continued with Digest-It once a day and U-Gard and simethicone twice a day.
- 12/28 Reduced simethicone to ten tablets twice a day.
- 1/3/2006 Reduced simethicone to eight tablets twice a day.
- 1/10 Antonio had another mild colic that resolved within 30 minutes with Banamine.
- 1/11 Antonio seemed somewhat uncomfortable with a noisy gut but not colicky. Gave him only half his grain and 12 tablets of simethicone.
- 1/12 Antonio had another mild colic that resolved within 30 minutes with Banamine. Continued with reduced grain. Contacted vet.
- 1/13 Put Antonio back on Gastro-Gard. Discontinued Strider and 1+1 and put him on ½ can low carb pellets.
- 1/18 Antonio examined by vet. Took him off Gastrogard. Increased his feed to 1 can of low carb and 1 can of plain crimped oats. Continued U-Gard, Digest-It, and 12 tablets of simethicone.
- 1/18-2/1 Gradually reduced simethicone by two tablets every four or five days
- 1/25 Vet removed a wolf tooth from Antonio and floated his teeth, which had a number of sharp edges.
- 2/1 Put Antonio on Peptic Ease in place of Digest-It.

- 2/5 Reduced U-Gard to half dose daily.
- 2/11 Discontinued U-Gard.
- 2/16 Antonio had another colic episode. Put him back on U-Gard and 12 tablets of Simethicone (he had been down to four tablets). Gave him a dose of Gastro-Gard. Symptoms improved within an hour.
- 3/2 Antonio was in obvious discomfort in the evening. Stomach was loud and tight and he was cranky. Gave him full dose of Gastro-Gard. His Simethicone had been gradually reduced to 4 tablets. Put him back on 12 tablets. His symptoms improved in about an hour.
- 3/4 AM: Discontinued oats in his feed. Increased low carb pellets to 1.5 cans
PM: Antonio in obvious discomfort again. Same symptoms as 3/2. Gave him another dose of Gastro-Gard. Not much improvement in his symptoms.
- 3/5 Antonio was listless and not much interested in his hay. Gave him another dose of Gastro-Gard. Not much improvement. Ate his grain but only half of his hay in evening.
- 3/6 AM: Antonio obviously uncomfortable. Only picked at his hay. Called vet. who suggested we take him to Vet Hospital. Made appointment for 3/7.
Gena worked on accupressure points. Seemed to help a little. He ate his hay and a handful of grain with his supplements (U-Gard, 12 Simethicone, Vit E).

PM: Gave Antonio a dose of Gastro-Gard and half dose (600#) of Banamine. His symptoms improved and he ate his hay and a handful of grain with his supplements (U-Gard, 12 Simethicone, Vit E).
- 3/7 Took Antonio to Vet Hospital. He was scoped, palpated rectally, and ultrasounded. No ulcers. Nothing else found.
- 3/10 Antonio did not finish his supertime hay and appeared a little off but not too uncomfortable; his gut sounds were gurgling. By bed check he had finished his hay. I checked him again around 3:30 AM and he was very cranky and uncomfortable and his gut sounds were very loud. I gave him #600 of Banamine and he improved somewhat in a half hour. I gave him a flake of hay.
- 3/11 Antonio did not finish his grain or hay for the AM feeding. He was clearly uncomfortable and his gut sounds were loud. Called vet and he recommended another #600 of Banamine and 10 simethicone tablets, which I administered. He seemed better after a half hour. His gut sounds quieted somewhat, but were still prominent. He ate all his hay.
- 3/13 Started Antonio on Cimetidine #10 800 mg dose twice daily. Discontinued Vit E supplement and Red Cell. Increased simethicone to 12 tablets.
- 3/14-3/21 Gut sounds generally quieter but still up and down. He has been eating all his hay and grain.
- 3/21 Increased cimetidine to #12 800 mg dose twice daily
- 3/21- Gut sounds consistently quieter, though still louder than our other horses. He seems much more normal in behavior--no signs of discomfort. His diet at this point is still 1.5 cans of Carb-Safe, Ugard, 12 Simethicone tablets, Peptic-Ease, and Horse Shine. He usually eats half his grain and then returns to hay, but comes back later to finish his grain.

Since Peptic-ease did not seem to make any difference, we switched over to Fast Track.

ReStore™ arrived but he would not eat the pelleted form. He refused his grain altogether. After a week or so of trying various quantities and crushing it we gave up and called the manufacturer, who sent the crumble form.

Started Antonio on the crumble form of ReStore™, which he accepted.
- 4/?? Antonio had another episode this evening. Gave him a dose of Banamine and it relieved his symptoms.
- 5/4 Antonio had another episode this morning after eating. He ate most of his grain and hay but was down and very gassy, and expelling gas. His belly also was bloated and sensitive to touch. After about 15 minutes he

got up and finished what little there was left of his grain and hay. His belly was still bloated, noisy and sensitive to touch.

6/1 Reduced Antonio's dose of Cimetidine from 12 to 10 800 mg tablets twice a day. His diet at this point for each feeding is 2 cans of Carb-Safe, Ugard, 12 Simethicone tablets, Fast Track, Horse Shine and ReStore™.

6/3 Reduced Antonio's dose of Cimetidine from 10 to 8 tablets twice a day.

6/5 Reduced Antonio's dose of Cimetidine from 8 to 6 tablets twice a day.

We eventually weaned Antonio off all the supplements to control his gas colics except ReStore™. After several weeks on ReStore™, his gas colic symptoms disappeared entirely and there has been no recurrence for more than a year.

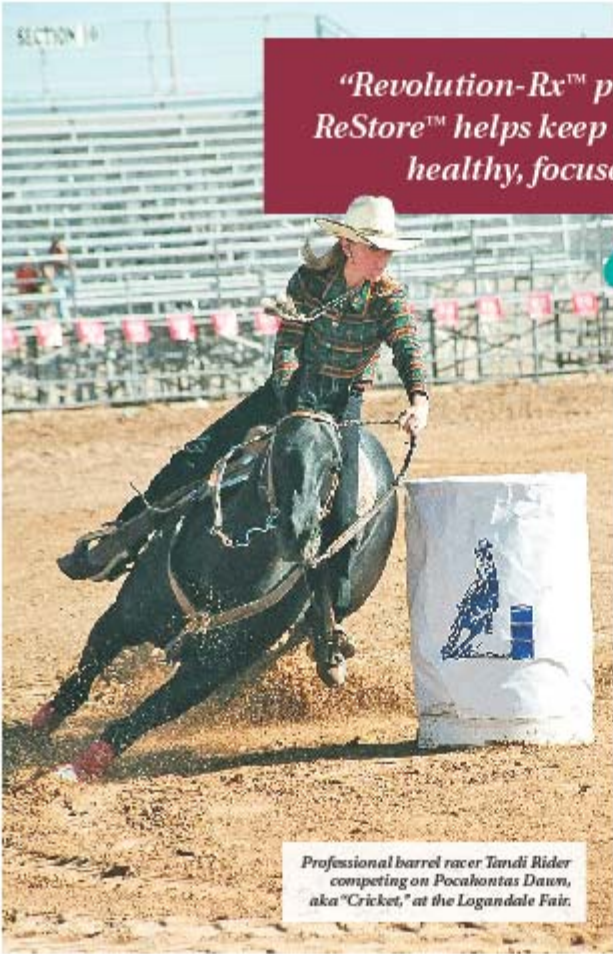
